It is made using HTML5 and CSS3 and has inbuilt web fonts, shortcodes along with working Ajax contact form and many important jQuery plugins for various functionalities and much more. Customizing Navigation

Add your desired navigation menu item under "<ul id="navigation">". The HTML navigation syntax is like "<li class="home">", where you will need to replace "#home" with the HTML ID where you will like the button to be linked to, "Home" with the title which you want to be seen when the user hovers over the navigation li, and most importantly, in "<li class="home">" you will need to give your navigation menu item a class, for its display image in navigation menu. After you are done with the class, just add something like

```
ul#navigation .class a {  
    background-image: url(../images/content/icon.png);  
}
```

to the style.css, where ".class" is the name of the class which you will specify, and replace "icon.png" with your desired image which you will like to be displayed. There are number of websites where you can get icons, one of them is http://www.iconfinder.com/free_icons.

Using Slider

Nivo Slider is being used for the slider, the images should be of 750px in width and 317px in height.

Using Shortcodes

Boxes

Using a shortcode is really easy, just use the HTML code where ever you want to use them, customize it, and it's done.

The HTML shortcode for a normal box is "`<div class="box normal rounded full">`". You can remove the "`rounded`" if you prefer square boxes. Similarly, you can remove the "`full`" if you don't want full border. For different box types, replace "`normal`" with your desired type, possible choices are **normal, info, tick, note, download, alert**.

Colored Buttons

For using buttons, use the HTML syntax "`Button`". Where "`Button`" is the button text which you will like to display, and replace "`red`" with your desired button color type, possible options are **silver, red, orange, green, aqua, teal, purple, pink**. If you don't specify any color, then default **blue** button will be displayed.

Icons Buttons

Using Icons Buttons is very much same as using colored buttons, use the HTML syntax "`Button`" and specify the button color like above, and change the "`search`" with desired button icon, possible choices are **search, stats, alert, tick, info, note, author, mail, notice, paper, people, download**.

Customizing Feed

In the article "`feed`", change <http://www.priteshgupta.com/feed/> with your desired RSS feed source, and "`10`" with your desired feed count.

Customizing Contact

A working PHP Ajax Contact Form is already in place, just replace your email id with "you@email.com" and "`Your Name`" with your name in "`process.php`".
