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This document covers the installation and use of this theme and will help guide you through the personalization process. Please read this document thoroughly if you are experiencing any difficulties. 1. Installation

1.1 FTP Uploading

Once you've produced your website, found a Host and registered a Domain Name, you need to transfer your site files on to your webspace (host's server) so people can at view your latest and greatest.

This procedure is called 'uploading' your website, and involves the transfer of files via FTP. The File Transfer Protocol allows computers to exchange files, upload or download, via the Internet.

Using your FTP program, upload the non-zipped theme folder into the root folder on your website server.

2. Image Slider

2.1 Slide Images

You can alter the images in your slider by saving them as "sliderimage1.jpg, sliderimage2.jpg, sliderimage3.jpg or sliderimage4.jpg" and dropping them in the "slider" folder (location: root/images/slider). There's also a nifty PSD named sliderimage.psd which has all the neat layer styles applied to it, in order to get your images to look like the preview. Just insert the image, clip it in, and save. It's already prepared for you.

2.2 Slide Links

Updating the links in the slideshow is quite easy as well. Just head into the source code index.html, and scroll down to lines 56-59. You'll see the href="#" there. Just fill in your link where the "#" is and your link is established. You may also update the image paths, alternate tags and image titles in these code lines as well.

3. Logo & Colors

3.1 Logo

We've made this theme so that you may change the text of the SLIC logo to whatever you'd like it to be. All you need to do is go into the index.html file and head to line 70. Just change the "Slic" text there to whatever you'd like. That's it. Really.

3.2 Colors

To edit the colors in the theme, open the styles.css file and search for the #0fa5e3 color (the blue that is the default base color.) Replace this with the color of your choice and you're all set.

3.3 Alternate Slider Backgrounds

Changing the slider background is rather simple. There's two different slider background files in the download here. All you need to do is ensure that you upload the background image that you like in the "...images/slider" folder and rename it "slidebg.png". Don't forget to rename it!

4. Navigation & Links

4.1 Navigation

To edit the navigation menu, just go into the index.html file and locate the code peices on lines: 73-77, 129-133, 194-198, 276-280.

And change the text (black in the code below) in each section.

5. Filtered Portfolio

5.1 Portfolio Images

To change the portfolio images in your filterable gallery, all you need to do is to load in your photos into the "...images/portfolio" folder. Name them in sequence as "work1.jpg" all the way up to twelve images (as currently designed).

5.2 Portfolio Filter/Categories

To change the categories, where it has the quotes after "data-tags", change these to your own. For example, the filter "Web Design"...change this to your own category and for multiple filters, list them separately with a comma in-between. This is found in the index.html file, lines: 146-182, as pictured below (not all of it's here, just the first part).

6. CSS Buttons

6.1 Button Colors

At the moment the colours used to create the buttons are using gradients, If you would like to change them please go to www.colorzilla.com/gradient-editor. Then select your gradient and replace the current colour under the button styles within the CSS sheet.

7. Team Members

7.1 Names

You can edit your team's names in lines 86, 95, 104 and 113. Simple change the text that is currently between the H1 tags and it's done. There's a snippet of the code below.

7.2 Images

Upload your images, named "team1.jpg" in sequence to 4 (as currently designed) in the "images/team" folder. That's all.

7.3 Social Media Links

We've designed this template to include a space for social media for each team member. You can easily upload different social media icons to replace the current, in the "images/team/social" folder. To change the links, just add in the full link where the "#" is located, beneath each team member's section within the code; each begins at lines: 86, 95, 104 and 113. Refer to the code below to see what you're looking for.
